- b. Specialists who met the criteria 4a and who attended the one-day instructor course

5. Duration of course:

- a. Online: two modules of 6 hours each
- Face to face one day (either as a separate course or in conjunction with APOA congresses or sectional meetings)

- a. Pre course online assessment MCQ
- b. Module-1 Recorded lectures (6 hours)
- c. Module-2 Recorded videos on skills (6 hours)
- d. Online assessment MCQ
- e. Module-3 Face to face skill station workshop (one day)
- f. Face to face final assessment MCQ type for certification

7. Pattern of exam:

- a. Online pre course MCQ type for knowledge assessment
- b. Online post lecture & video MCQ type for assessment of knowledge upgradation
- c. Face to face final assessment MCQ type for certification
- 8. Certification: Yes
- 9. Any validity: 2-4 years or NO
- 10. Modes and ways to conduct: As in 6
